

## How to get there

### By Road

From the Athens International Airport (Eleftherios Venizelos), we can arrange for a taxi to take you straight to Kosta, the closest point on the Peloponnesus mainland, and from there to the island of Spetses.

If you are driving yourself, upon leaving the airport, you take the “**Attiki**” **motorway**, towards **Elefsina**. You then leave at the **Epidavros** exit, and follow the sign-posting for Spetses. You should reach Kosta in about 2.5 hours. From there, you can choose between 3 different ways to reach the island:

- by ferry boat, journey time 15 minutes, 4 times per day, all year round (please ask us about the ferry timetable).
- by kaiki (small local wooden boat), journey time 15-20 minutes, leaving whenever they fill up, run only during summer months.
- by water-taxi, journey time 10 minutes, available around the clock, winter and summer.

Private-use cars, of course, are not allowed onto the island. There is a paying car-park at Kosta for this purpose.

### By Sea

From the main port of Piraeus, you can catch the Flying Dolphin or Catamaran, belonging to the company Hellenic Seaways ([www.hellenicseaways.gr](http://www.hellenicseaways.gr)), or the ones belonging to Euroseas ([www.euroseas.com](http://www.euroseas.com)). You can find timetables and book online for both companies using the web addresses given above. The journey to Spetses is approximately 2-2.5 hours, sometimes a little longer, depending on how many ports the vessel calls at on the way.
